Cambodia Cassette Bible Institute Completes Year One!

When we returned to Cambodia a few years ago, one of the things we did was to visit with various missionaries and national church leaders to decide what areas of need the church had that media ministries might help to address. Without exception, everyone we spoke to said the number one need was for discipleship. When we first came to Cambodia in 1994, there were only about 120 evangelical churches in the country. Today, there are more than 2400! But with the great explosion in evangelism, there has been a lack of effective discipleship and training. That's when I became involved with the Cambodia Cassette Bible Institute (CCBI).

CCBI was formed in cooperation with several different denominations, missions agencies and Bible schools, with the goal of providing ongoing cassette based distance education for lay-leaders and pastors. A pilot program was launched to see if this would be an effective tool for the church, and then in January of 2005 we launched the full three year program.

This month we complete our first full year of operation! We have close to 100 students studying in 7 different provinces. One study group is even made up entirely of former Khmer Rouge! Please pray that God would continue to bless the work of CCBI and use it to strengthen His church!
