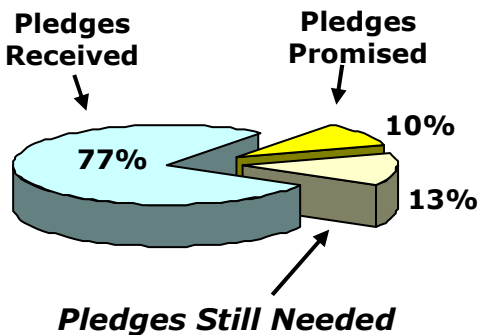

Looking For Answers

The last week of January once again saw the Cambodian capitol of Phnom Penh erupt in violence. Fueled by a combination of long standing ethnic strife and a false media report of a Thai actress insulting Cambodia, mobs took to the streets to express their frustrations by looting and burning the Thai embassy and attacking Thai owned businesses and property. Before the unrest ended, more than 23 million dollars of damage had been done, Thailand had evacuated it's citizens and broken off official relations with Cambodia, including suspending aid and closing their border to Cambodian citizens.

These events only serve to highlight the Cambodian people's frustration with their current situation. With national parliamentary elections scheduled for this summer, it seems likely that unrest throughout the country will continue and even grow in the months to come. The world continues to point the Cambodian people toward political and economic "answers", but the only real answer for the future of Cambodia is the new life and hope found in Jesus Christ.

We are in the final stages of preparing to return to Cambodia in April to bring them the good news of the Prince of Peace, but we still have about 13% of our monthly support to raise. Your help may be the answer we are looking for! Please pray and ask God what part he would have YOU play in bringing the real answer to the Cambodian People.
