Leadership Update!

One of the greatest privileges we have had is to see the kids who have been a part of our orphanage in the past grow and develop into all that God has planned for them. His plans and ways are so far beyond what we can imagine: as God told Samuel, "The Lord does not look at the things man looks at." (NIV 1 Sam 16:7)

At many of the churches we visited, I shared about one of the young men from our orphanage named Eing Samath. He is now the pastor of a growing church in the capital city of Phnom Penh and also serves on the Cambodian Assemblies of God leadership committee. Now, God is again taking him in new directions!

Shortly after our return to the field I was able to meet with him for a short time. During that meeting we made plans to work together on recording and producing a worship album featuring his church's worship team (scheduled to begin later this month). But he also shared with me some exciting news: he has just finalized plans to turn his church over to a new pastor and go to Singapore to study at a four year Bible college. After completing his studies, he plans to return to Cambodia and head up the faculty at the Assemblies of God Bible Institute for training future pastors! We are thrilled that God continues to multiply His church in new ways! Please keep pastor Samath in your prayers!

Twig's Tree House

Over the past month I have been able to partner with a number of churches and Canadian Christian production company to help produce a series of 14 basic children's discipleship lessons on video.

Set in a tree house, six puppets (a twig, a rock, a bird, a snake, a flower and a squirrel) learn about salvation as well as basic Christian values and principles. It is designed specifically for Cambodia and has a great potential to reach primary school children, and develop Cambodian talent for future projects. While our involvement is to serve as more of a technical advisor, we believe this will help to build the experience and relationships that will be a key to our future ministry.
